

## LEARNING FROM OTHERS – COMMON UNDERSTANDING

By expressing an interest in sharing or learning in this way, you agree to the following Common Understanding:

The Guest agrees to the following basic principles:

- To attend the session that has been agreed, on your own (and communicate at the earliest opportunity if you are no longer able to attend)
- To be respectful to the session, to be prompt and observe quietly, unless invited to sing along
- To be respectful to the choral leader(s), expect to see things done in a different way, and understand that there will be reasons behind this approach
- To ask permission before taking any photos or videos, as there may be restrictions
- To refrain from any social media posts unless these have been mutually agreed with your main contact
- To feel free to talk to the choral leader(s) in the break and / or at the end of the session
- To be open to offering a reciprocal invitation to your own choir session

The Host agrees to the following basic principles:

- To provide full details of when and where the session is taking place
- To provide a contact name and number
- To give a little background to the choir
- To welcome and supervise as appropriate, in particular regarding any children or young people
- To introduce the choral leader(s), and for the choral leader(s) to be open to a conversation about the session
- To advise what is permissible regarding photos, videos or social media issues

Any additional requirements or expectations will be communicated by the Host or Guest in their communications prior to the session.
